ABOUT THIS COURSE

This course is designed to introduce offshore operators to the philosophy and underpinning knowledge behind Major Emergency Management on an offshore facility. The intent is to train personnel through theory, simulation and practical demonstration in the techniques of Major Emergency Management To review and test company procedures related to Emergency Response. To identify any areas of deficiency in Emergency Response (site specific) and to increase awareness of Asset Loss Prevention. This program is a nationally accredited program in Australia and fulfils the requirements of the PMA08 OMIR Units of Competency. This program can be conducted as a generic or a site specific course if required. The simulator is configured to replicate site detection and process logic

OBJECTIVE

The course is designed for those who are destined to assume the role of PIC in an emergency and for them to develop their skills and understanding of what they should do when faced with a major emergency.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

The course is designed for those who are destined to assume the role of EM or a member of the Emergency Management Team (EMT) in an emergency or anyone from a high-risk industry who needs to understand more about the management of major emergencies.



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
